Short summary of initiative (please indicate the start date/duration if relevant)	In September 2021, the Macao SAR CCAC joined the “Global Operational Network of Anti-Corruption Law Enforcement Authorities (GlobE Network), created under the auspices of the UNODC.
Detailed description of initiative	In order to facilitate and support international cooperation and technical assistance in the prevention and fight against corruption, the GlobE Network was created under the auspices of the UNODC. The Macao SAR (represented by the CCAC) joined this network at an earlier stage and since then, it has been attending all the network initiatives (virtually), including its participation in the Steering Committee Meetings and Plenary Meetings, as well as its replies to all requests sent to the members by the GlobE Network Secretariat (expl: Questionnaire on Informal Cooperation in Transnational Corruption Cases).
Lessons learned in implementing the initiative	---
Challenges encountered in implementing the initiative	Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, it has not been possible for any CCAC staff (including the designated “contact point”) to participate in any of the meetings promoted by the GlobE Network in person so far.
