<b>Short summary of initiative</b>	The Global Operational Network of Anti-Corruption Law Enforcement Authorities (GlobE Network) is a platform for peer-to-peer information exchange and informal cooperation for anti-corruption law enforcement authorities in all UN Member States and States Parties to the UNCAC to better identify, investigate and prosecute cross-border corruption offences and recover stolen assets.
<b>Detailed description of initiative</b>	As the establishment of the network is in accordance with main purpose of the UNCAC focusing on enhancing international cooperation and technical assistance between States Parties, Thailand, by Office of the NACC, has joined the network with a view to implementing the Convention and the commitments contained in the Declaration. Office of the NACC had continuously witnessed procedures of setting up the network, from participating in the Expert Group Meeting on the Establishment of the Network in March 2021, United Nations General Assembly Special Session against Corruption in June 2021, and the first and second Plenary Meeting of the Network in November 2021 and June 2022, respectively. Apart from enhanced international cooperation, the Network is a means providing better convenience in interagency coordination among State Parties and introduction to Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters.
<b>Lessons learned in implementing the initiative</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The GlobE Network is set to be a tool enhancing international cooperation without causing any complications and conflicts with the existing network.</li> <li>- The Network has launched its Secure Communication Platform (SCP) to be used on voluntary basis to support the direct communication between the network members and them and the secretariat.</li> <li>- The GlobE workplan 2022 and the workplan for Knowledge and Capacity Development</li> </ul>
