	 Be the competent authority for international cooperation under international obligations and agreements in anticorruption; Execute in accordance with the request for assistance from foreign countries in corruption cases, submitted by the central authority (the Attorney General) under the law on mutual legal assistance, to proceed, or to consider providing assistance to a foreign country in a corruption case which is not a request for assistance under the law on mutual legal assistance in criminal matters. When it appears to the NACC, regardless of allegation, that a foreign public official, official of public international organisation or associated person commits an offence related to bribery, the NACC may consider submitting the matter to the foreign authority having the duties and power to undertake the case under the law of such country. In this regard, international cooperation shall be proceeded under the law on such matter. Upon a request for assistance from a foreign country under the law on mutual legal assistance in criminal matters to proceed against a foreign public official, official of a public international organization, or any person on the grounds that an offence was committed related to bribery or the justice obstruction, the NACC shall have the powers to conduct inquiry and make a decision or to perform any other act as requested
